### RIDERS SAFETY ON THE ROADS

- Whilst out on the roads remember to not drive on the highway.
- After dark you will require a front and back light fitted to your bike.
- Ensure you adhere to all road signs and do not ride on the footway; this is illegal and may result in a fine.
- Please make sure you have your ID with you and light when you are outside the venue, on public road.

To descend from the pass you either go down the Tremola, after the race, or you go down the main road where you pass through a fairly long and dark tunnel. In that tunnel, light is mandatory.

## 7. EVENT SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

### 1. General rules

The "Championnats d'Europe des Grimpeurs UEC 2023" is organised by the Union Européenne de Cyclisme in collaboration with the Tremola Pro Bike.

The event will be organised in accordance with rules of the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI) and these rules will be the reference for everything that is not mentioned in the current document.

The "Championnats d'Europe des Grimpeurs UEC 2023" consist time trial races, scheduled **on 30 July 2023**.

The "Championnats d'Europe des Grimpeurs UEC 2023" is open to individual riders and National teams, license holders of their National Federation.

The "Championnats d'Europe des Grimpeurs UEC 2023" is open to individual riders with or without license.

The individual riders without a UCI license will be part of the Cyclosportive category.

Medals for the first 3 men and medals for the first 3 women will be awarded. No European jersey.

### 3.4 General rules

The distribution of race numbers and the transponders for all the above-mentioned categories in articles 3.1 and 3.2 will take place during the Confirmation of starters procedure.

The riders must present their jersey and shorts to the College of Commissaires for validation upon confirmation of the starters.

Riders age categories, in those events shall be as defined by the UCI.

## 5. Procedures before start

#### **Signature mandatory for the following categories:**

- **Men Elite, Women Elite, Men U23, Women U23, Men Junior, Women Junior**

Riders must present themselves on the signing area.

The signature area will be open 50 minutes before the start and will be closing 15 minutes before the start. Riders who have not signed will not be able to start.

## 6. Starting procedure

Individual start every 30 seconds – **3 minutes depending on the number of riders participating.**

## **7. Vehicles convoy**

No vehicles will be allowed to follow the race

## **8. Equipment / Material inspection**

Regular road bikes or TT bikes may be used.

Material inspection will be carried out before the start, according to the procedures that will be indicated by the College of Commissaires.

### **Jersey during the time trial**

All jerseys (club, national team, regional team) are allowed.

## **9. Technical neutral assistance and feeding zone / waste zones**

Gruppo Servizio Corse FSA - Vision will provide neutral assistance.

3 technical zones are foreseen on the course. Fondo Bosco, Motto Bartola and on the Tremola in the turn named Out dét Sant'Antóni

Feeding zone will be located in Motto Bartola

Waste zones will be located 100 meters before and after Motto Bartola. Riders must respect the environment and use the waste areas.

## **10. Award Ceremonies and prize money list**

The first 3 riders of the Final Classification of each category will present themselves for the official ceremony.

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

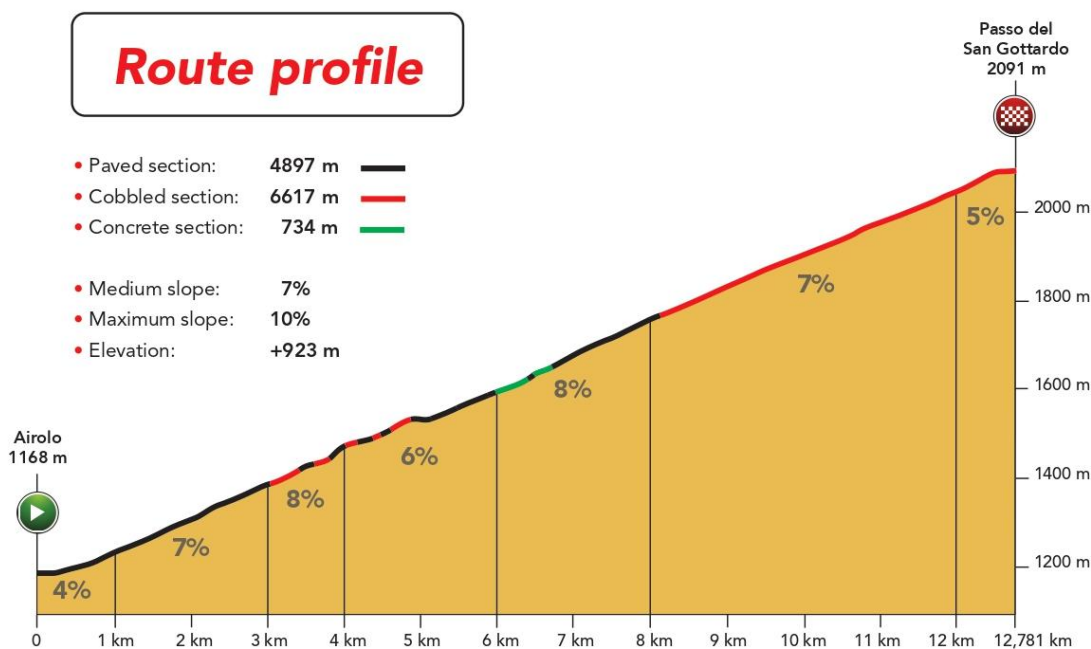
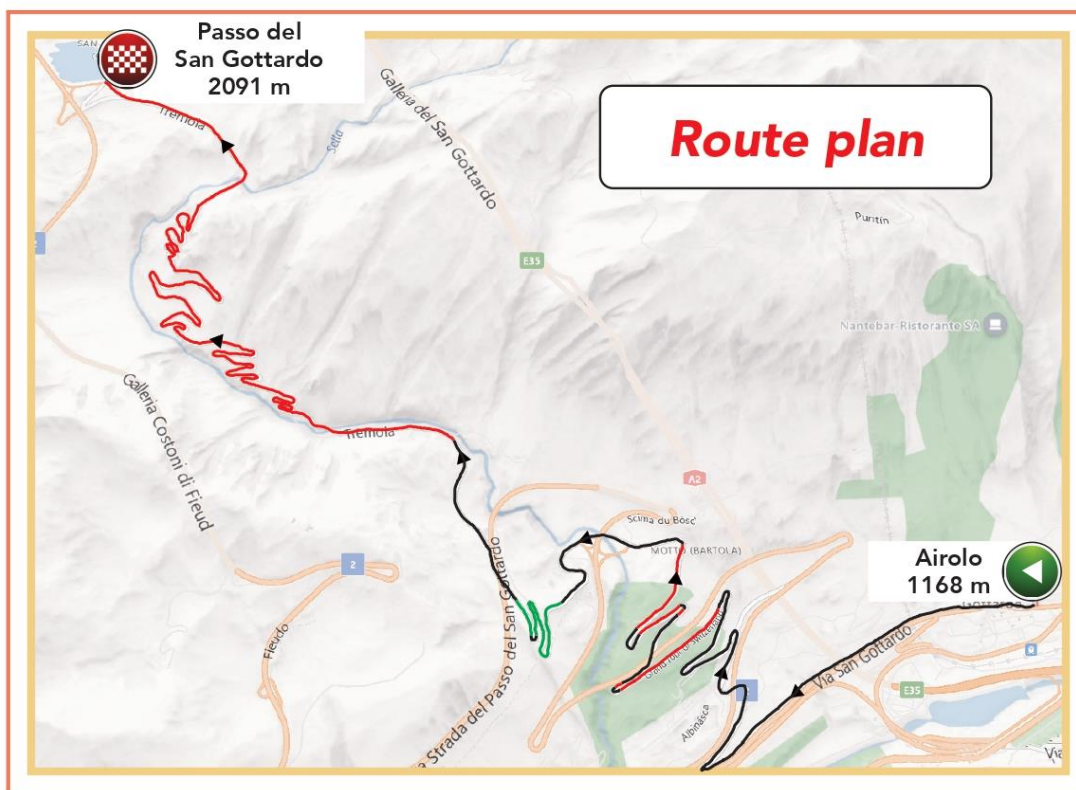
### **13. Responsibilities**
